Building Safety Committee Reports

- Ryan Evans – MS conducted fire drill and severe weather drill (tornado)
- Dr. Sexsmith – HS had a spontaneous fire drill and secure drill. Will do weather drill next month. Last week, learner pulled fire alarm (Thursday) after change of periods. Took most of period to clear. EMS responded. Full accountability for staff and learners at the end.
  - Making sure everyone is on the same page. Old directive to NOT evacuate immediately unless an announcement was made. Need clarification on what the district’s directive is and look at amending the previous memo.

Training

- ALICE Basics for Staff Training – online training through Navigate 360. Staff must complete by January 31, 2023
- ALICE Basics for Students
  - Elementary: ALICE Lesson Plans and “I’m Not Scared, I’m Prepared” books
  - Secondary: ALICE Lesson Plans
    - MS: Mr. Evans suggests waiting until staff have completed training to push out lessons for students
    - HS: Mr. Archer suggested having a debrief with staff after they complete training, so everyone is pushing out the same message to students.
    - HS: Dr. Sexsmith voiced concern over staff absences during drills/event
    - Dr. Willis: Parent Advisory asked what resources will be pushed out to families so they can have a conversation with their learner and answer questions they may have. Guidance through I Love You Foundation.
