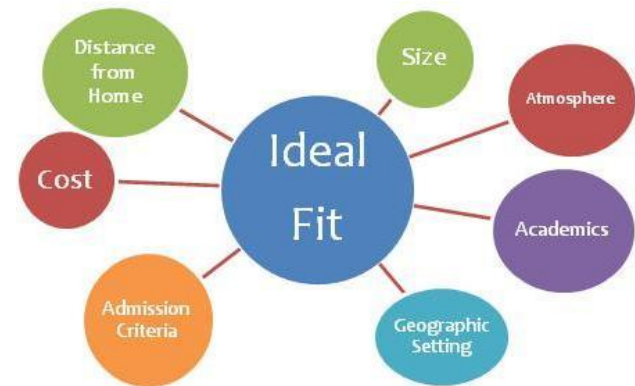






# The Best Fit/Match College

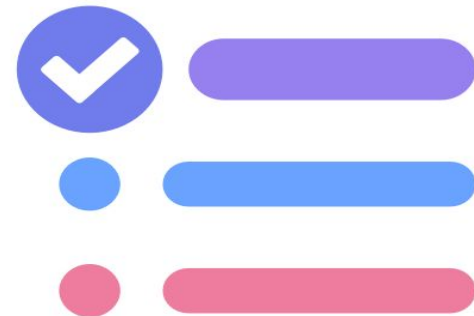

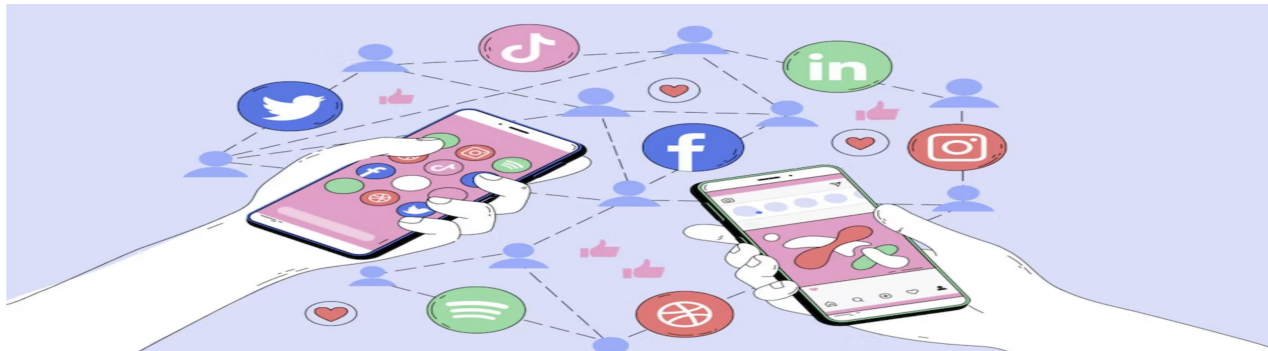




# Academic Integrity & Discipline
