## **It's lost Week-End For Marian Gridders**

Marian suffered a 19-0 defeat Saturday afternoon as the Spartans made their weary way through the second half of a doubleheader week-end.

Luther South found the Marian line an easy solution for a three-pronged ground game which netted two touchdowns in the first half and another in the third quarter.

The loss was the second of the season and second in two days for Marian, routed the night before by Wilmington. Marian has won one.

Jay Lyons, senior halfback for Luther, counted both of the first half touchdowns, on runs of 16 and eight yards. Both times he slipped through shaky tackling attempts.

Quarterback Chuck Schmidt scored the last six-pointer on a one-yard sneak during a rainstorm which dampened throughout the second half.

Joe Widlicka, Luther fullback, outgained the Marian squad on the ground in the first half, 77-68. He also added the lone extra point.
