**Second Straight**

**Marian on Rampage; Chalks Up 52-0 Win**

Marian ran roughshod over Angel Guardian, 52 to 0, Saturday afternoon in Chicago. It was the second straight and third victory in five starts for the Chicago Heights school.

Aided by sharp blocking in the line, Marian's fast backs ran through Angel Guardian almost at will, particularly in the second half.

The Spartans used most of the first period with a 76 yard touchdown march requiring 10 plays. Quarterback Joe Bijak went across from the 1 yard line.

Bob McEvoy sped 10 yards for a second period score, while Carl Swanson ran 19 yards for another. Jack Schreiber booted two extra points to give Coach Joe DeSoto's club a 20-0 halftime lead.

McEvoy tallied again on a 15 yard sweep in the third quarter, climaxing an 80 yard drive which was completed in just five plays.

Marian drove 50 yards in nine plays, Mike Kuhl plunging the final yard, before the period ended.

Swanson galloped 40 yards for a score early in the final quarter to boost Marian's advantage to 38-0.

Steve Bergstrom and freshman Tom Bijak both counted on two yard plunges before the game ended. Schreiber added points after both touchdowns.
