Mathematics	3+**	Completion of Algebra I & Geometry. (+) All students must have a math course or math-content experience all four years.
Science	3	Physical Science, Biology, one additional science course
Arts Education	½	All Art, Music, Technical Drawing & Design, and Communication Technology courses meet this requirement.
Physical Education	1	Foundations of PE (1/2), and one (1/2) PE Elective
Health	½	Health & Wellness
Computer	½	Office Software Applications, Communication Technology I, Technical Drawing & Design I - each meet this requirement.
Electives	10	Arts Education; World Languages; Business Education; Technology Education; Family and consumer Science; LRTC Programs; Additional courses to complete 26 credits required. Includes; +1 CR math-content course** <u>taken senior year.</u>
