A substitute teacher is a vital part of student learning in the absence of a regular teacher. To be a substitute teacher in DCS, you must:

- hold a current or expired teaching license, or
- be at least two years beyond high school graduation, and have two years of relevant experience OR completed two years of college
- successfully complete an approved substitute teacher training program (**NOTICE: ALL FEES LISTED BELOW ARE WAIVED THROUGH FEBRUARY 28TH! CONTACT KELLY KLUTTZ BELOW FOR AN ONLINE CODE TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION.**)
