

Immunizations required by the New Jersey State Department of Health
Summary of NJ Immunization Requirements by Grade Level

Required vaccines vary based on student age. A complete list is available on Sayreville Public Schools Website (<https://www.sayrevillek12.net/families/registration> AND <https://www.sayrevillek12.net/district/departments/health-services>) as well as the NJ Department of Health website (https://www.nj.gov/health/cd/imm_requirements/).

A summary by grade level can be found below:

Project Before PreK Students:

- **DTaP** – 4 doses
- **Polio** – 3 doses
- **Hib** – 1 dose (given on or after 1st birthday)
- **PCV** – 1 dose (given on or after 1st birthday)
- **MMR** – 1 dose
- **Varicella** – 1 dose
- **Influenza** – Seasonal Dose needs to be submitted by December 31st of the current year for children age 6-59 months.

Elementary and Upper Elementary Students:

- **DTaP**
 - **Kindergarten – 1st grade:** 4 doses (one dose must be given on or after the 4th birthday or any 5 doses)
 - **2nd grade – 5th grade:** 3 doses
- **Polio**
 - **Kindergarten – 1st grade:** 3 doses (one dose must be given on or after the 4th birthday or any 4 doses)
 - **2nd grade – 5th grade:** 3 doses
- **MMR** – 2 doses
- **Varicella** – 1 dose
- **Hepatitis B** – 3 doses

Middle School and High School Students:

- **DTaP** – 3 doses
- **Polio** – 3 doses
- **MMR** – 2 doses
- **Varicella** – 1 dose
- **Hepatitis B** – 3 doses
- **Meningococcal** – 1 dose (given no earlier than 10 years old)
- **Tdap** – 1 dose

Physical Exam:

- Physical examination by student's personal physician including a vision and hearing screening, within a year of September entrance (e.g., the twelve months preceding start of school.).

Mantoux Test for Tuberculosis:

- If your child is transferring into the school district from another country they may be required to submit a TB test prior to starting school. A nurse will contact the parent with more information if this is required.
