Reviewed and approved meeting minutes from November 17, 2020.

### Family and Community Involvement/Physical Education

- Family Fun Night has been cancelled due to COVID. There will not be a need to send cancellation notices since the advertisements have not begun.
- Fitnessgram - There is not a waiver for this school year. All 3rd - 10th grade PE students are required to complete the assessment (face-to-face or virtual). PE teachers need to contact parents of virtual students to explain the assessment process or schedule a time to complete at their home campus.
- CPR training for seniors at AHS is scheduled for the first week of May.

### Health Education

- Abstinence Program - 6th, 8th, 10th grade. The program chosen by SHAC was, *Choosing the Best*. The program will be presented to the School Board for approval at the April 12th board meeting.
- COVID-19 Update: AISD's COVID dashboard looks really good right now. AISD will continue to mask, social distance, and quarantine as outlined in the COVID Guidance Document. AISD will continue to supply masks, as needed, and remain positive about wearing masks regardless of the state's mandate being lifted.

### Health Services

- Hearing & Vision Screenings - nurses are working diligently to get these completed on all campuses.
- Cook Children's Telemed - AEN was chosen as a pilot school for COVID testing, but start date has not been given as of yet.

- As part of the 2020-2025 Comprehensive Needs Assessment to create district goals, it was determined by the committee when analyzing data that an area of need was the social emotional well-being of our scholars and educators. A district goal was developed using the five CASEL components (Self-Awareness, Self-management, Social-awareness, Relationship management, and Responsible decision-making). The Performance Objective for 2020-2021 is to address three of the five components (Self-awareness, Self-management and Social-awareness). Dr. Nunez and Dr. Diaz is currently researching different curriculums to purchase for the implementation of the goal. The plan is to have an assessment tool in place by the end of this school year, given to scholars and educators, for data to drive the curriculum implementation necessary for the 2021-2022 school year.
