As you know, **English** and **French** are taught at ISN from Pre-K to Grade 12, **Spanish** is taught in the Middle School and is now also optional in grades 9 to 12. These language lessons are part of our curriculum. However, additional lessons in other languages can also be taken at school, on a one-to-one basis, in small groups or even online/remotely.

These extra language lessons are for:

- native speakers who would like to sit examinations in their mother tongue
- students who would like to present an additional or new language for the International Baccalaureate (as a first or a second language, or at Ab Initio level)
- intermediate and beginner students, in many different languages and at all ages.

During this current academic year, qualified teachers in several different World Languages have been teaching a number of our students at all levels, and also preparing some of them for the IB and IGCSE exams

Our language teachers are **external**, they also work in other schools and universities on the Riviera.
