### Application for Membership

The SNHS is an honor society bestowed upon students in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The requirements for membership include the following:

- Must be a junior or senior.
- Must maintain at least a 90% average in all science courses; and an 85% overall.
- A junior member must be enrolled in physics, or at least 1 honors course or AP science course during their 11th grade year.
- Junior members must have completed three science courses or be currently enrolled in the third course. (Science Research Program is considered an advanced level course.)
- A senior member must be enrolled in at least one AP level science class during or prior to the twelfth grade year. Senior members must have completed four science courses or be currently enrolled in the fourth science course. (Science Research Program is considered an advanced level course.)
- Must be available to tutor in a science area of strength and preference.
- Must complete 40 hours of community service. (20 Science Related)
  - You will also receive 1hr. of science related service for attending SNHS Club meetings.
- Must attend at least 75% of the chapter meetings, activities or events for the year prior to applying (ex. During sophomore year if planning on applying during junior year) and maintain good standing in the club.

Application and Selection Process:

- Only complete applications, including a copy of your unofficial transcript and two teacher recommendations, received by the deadline will be considered.
- Application and teacher recommendations deadline is February 18, 2022
- All applications and teacher recommendations must be emailed to Mrs. Castillo.
- Accepted members will be notified by March 4, 2022.
- The Science National Honor Society Induction Ceremony will be on Wednesday, March 23, 2022.

If a copy of your unofficial transcript is not included, your application will not be considered for acceptance.
- ***Two teacher recommendations*** are required – one recommendation must be from a science teacher. Email Mrs. Castillo the two names of the teachers you would like to recommend you (*one must be a science teacher*). Teachers will respond on a Google Sheet sent to them by Mrs. Castillo. Both teacher recommendations must be received by the application deadline to be considered for acceptance.
