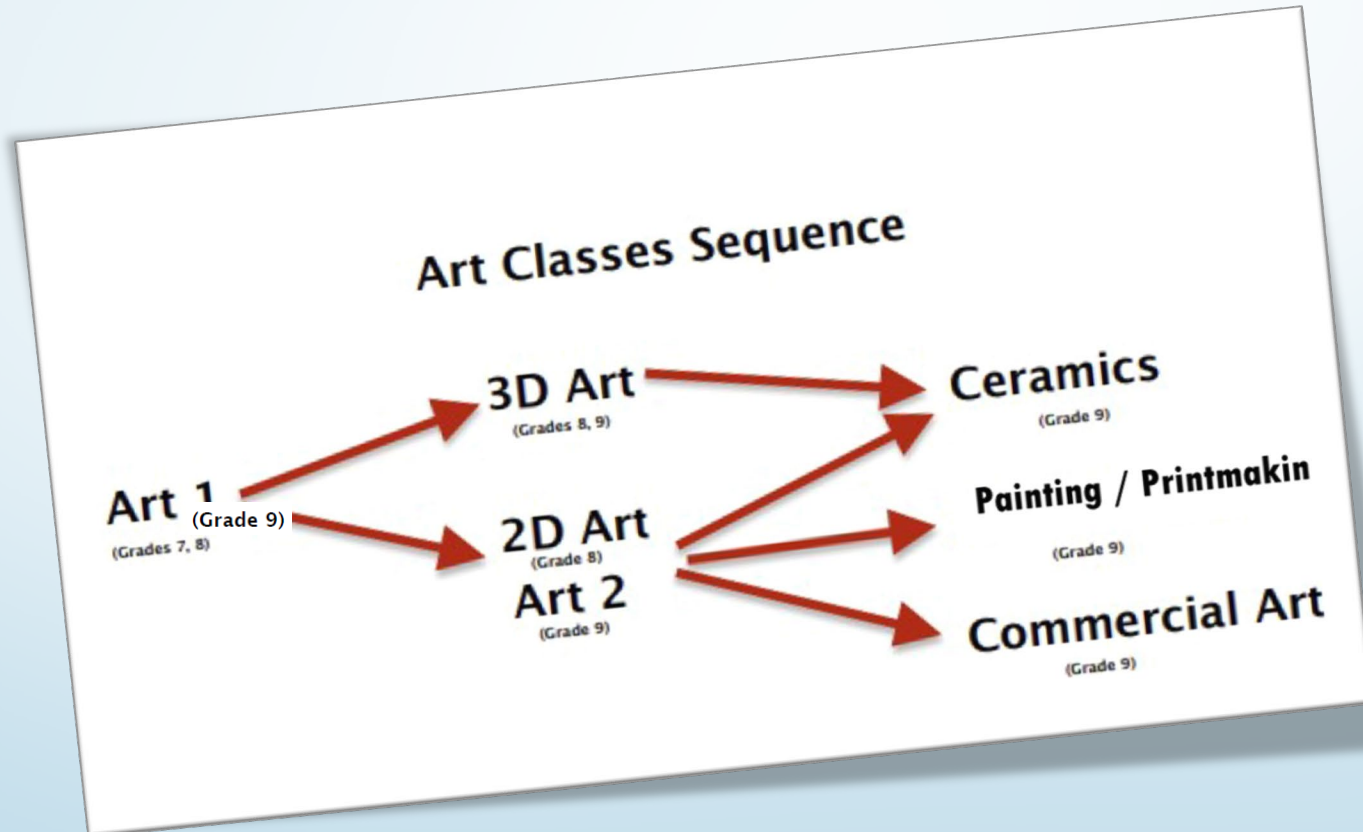

- **LATINOS IN ACTION (LIA)** This class is a Peer Leadership class for Latino students. It is designed to enrich the life of students by developing the following skills: • Writing and reading • Resume development • Speaking, listening, interpersonal and presentation • Work ethic/responsibility • Time management • Teamwork/cooperation • Decision making/Goal setting
- **WORLD GEOGRAPHY 1/WORLD GEOGRAPHY HONORS 1:** The graduation requirement for these classes is .5 which means that you only need one semester to fulfill the requirement. *World Geography 2 and World Geography Honors 2 are HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for students seeking scholarship opportunities. AP Human Geography is still a full year.
- **HISTORY HIJINKS: HISTORY'S HIJINKS:** This course is an exploration of interesting historical events from ancient times to now using historical reasoning and critical thinking. Topics could include, but are not limited to heroes and villains, cultures, revolutions, major conflicts, and natural disasters. This class is recommended for those who want to continue learning about our amazing history.
- **STUDENT ASSISTANTS:** Students who want to be a Teachers Assistant or Counseling Assistant will *pick up and return* the application in the Counseling Office. Students who want to be a Front Office Assistant, Library Aid, Copy Room Assistant or Peer Tutor will *pick up and return* the application to the area where it was picked up.
