Position: Indoor Soccer League Director (Grades 4K-3rd) - Part-time seasonal

Summary: The League Director works under the direct supervision of the Youth Sports Manager

Dates: March 4 - May 6, Tuesday's 5:00-8:00pm, Saturday's 9am-5pm (OFF 3/28, 4/1, 4/8)

Qualifications:

- Individuals must be at least 18 years of age.
- Individuals should possess thorough knowledge of sport or activity.
- Must have knowledge of specific sport rules and regulations and know how to apply them according to game play.
- Must have 2-3 years of experience as a Youth Soccer coach or coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Model our youth sports values of inclusion, skill development, balance, and lifelong enjoyment
- Lead volunteer coaches each week through pre-planned practice plans
- Provide leadership to staff and volunteer coaches; communicate practice plans, provide direction on how to properly implement, and evaluate performance.
- Assist staff with setting up equipment for each practice.
- Complete Site Supervisor duties which consist of opening and closing the site.
- Serve as Game Day Supervisor; help setup court for game play, ensure games start on time, help maintain a positive atmosphere for all players, parents and coaches.
- Must have thorough knowledge of fundamental skills of the sport and experience coaching children ages 4-8.
- Communicate program expectations and rules to the participants/spectators.
- Assist in problem solving with participant conflicts.
- Communicate pertinent program information or needs to the Recreation Program Manager.
- Collect and submit timecards at the request of the Recreation Program Manager.
- Administer basic first aid and complete and submit accident report forms.
- Assist with the recruitment of parent coaches, as needed.
- Facilitate distribution and collection of program materials as assigned.
- Serve as a mentor for the youth sports program officials.
- Other duties as assigned.
