Week 4: Monday, July 10th through Friday, July 14th	\$525.00
Week 5: Monday, July 17th through Friday, July 21st	\$525.00
Week 6: Monday, July 24th through Friday, July 28th	\$525.00

A 50% down payment is due at registration. Please note that it includes a deposit of \$262.50 per child per session, which is non-refundable and non-transferable. The 50% remaining balance will be due by Friday, May 26th. If a child is enrolled after May 26th, the payment is due in full. Refunds minus the non-refundable and non-transferable deposit may be requested.

**EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM:** We also offer an extended day program for an additional fee, for our summer camp with an earlier morning start time (drop-off between 8:00 to 8:30am) and afternoon pick-up time (from 3:30 through 5:30pm). These services are meant to be prepaid. Campers will be automatically charged for the Afternoon Extended Day if they are still on campus after 3:30pm. Unused Extended Day dollars will be refunded.

- Prepaid Morning Fee: \$10 per day (otherwise \$15 per day).
- Prepaid Afternoon Fee: \$20 per day (otherwise \$25 per day).

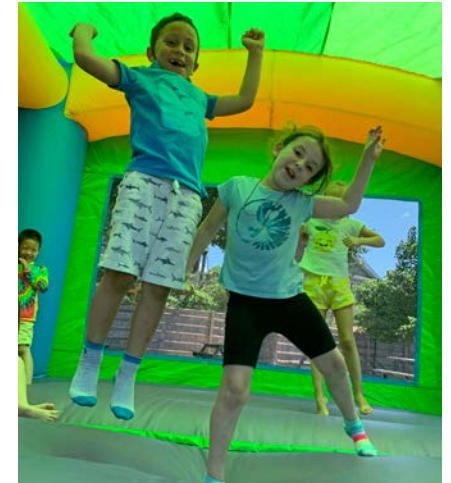
