- Similar to a typical college model, the Upper School schedule allows students to own their learning in a variety of ways — from tackling Shakespearean sonnets to spending one of the two daily free periods studying, catching up on homework, or forming a new club.
- Every senior participates in a Senior Cooperative (Co-Op), a program in which students volunteer at an organization in Central Massachusetts, drawing on their academic and personal interests to make a

meaningful contribution to the community. Seniors put their unique talents and skills to use in the real world, giving them confidence and a sense of purpose for future endeavors.

- Whatever your passion may be, there is a club or student organization for you in the Upper School. Whether it's building hightech robots with the national champion Robodogs team or knitting hats for a local shelter, Bancroft has a student group for you.
