
### **Prayer Group for the Priests of OLGC**

## The AMBO: Part 2

Last week we focused on the Ambo, the place where Sacred Scripture is proclaimed. As was previously stated, proclaiming the Word of God, readers exercise their responsibilities in the liturgical celebration. God speaks to the faithful through them, and the effectiveness of their proclamation depends on their conviction, preparation, understanding and delivery. [Introduction of the Order of the Mass, pg. 10]



The faithful, by hearing the reading from sacred texts, may conceive in their hearts a sweet and living affection for Sacred Scripture.

[Constitution of Sacred Liturgy, "Sacrosantum Concilium," no. 24]

The types of Scriptural readings include a variety of literary forms to convey the message of salvation. We can hear: narratives, poetry of the psalms, lamentations, parables, prophetic oracles, theological expositions, ancient Israelite

history, Christ's teaching, miracles. Acts of the apostles etc. An awareness of the literary form of a particular reading or psalm and a knowledge of the sacred author's style enables the lector to proclaim more fully and with great understanding the tone and content of the text. In the Readings, as explained by the homily, God speaks to his people, opening up to them the mystery of redemption and salvation and offering them spiritual

### **ABOUT NOSTALGIA**

I don't know about anyone else, but the Christmas holidays find me taking a deep dive into nostalgia. This is easy to do at such a happy time of year when traditions run strong and putting ornaments on the tree is like a walk through your life as you remember how you acquired each one. But we don't engage in nostalgia only at holiday time. I believe we're there much more often than we realize.

Socializing is a big thing when one lives in an active retirement community like I do. I have dinner with various friends about twothirds of every month, choosing to "eat in" the other days because I still enjoy cooking. During the meal, we invariably end up talking about our personal experiences growing up, family lore, and traditions. In this sense, we're indulging in nostalgia, and I'm happy to say that most of the time we end up with a lot of laughing at the table, and go back to our apartments feeling pretty darned good. From various things I've read about the subject, there's a good bit of science about nostalgia. It helps create endorphins, that group of hormones that make us feel good. As elders, we probably engage in nostalgia more than others simply because we have so much more in our memory banks. This is a good time to think about it, because the holidays are over and the coming weeks of winter might be an appropriate time to reflect on such things. For me, this is the time I find myself in a more contemplative mood. I think the

grayness of the season makes me feel this way.

While downsizing prior to moving to my new community, I had to dispose of many Christmas tree ornaments because I wasn't planning on taking my huge tree with me. That was emotionally difficult. However, I saved the most precious ones, the oldest ones from my husband's and my childhood. In



the bunch were a few made by my children and grandchildren when they were in the second or third grade. This past Christmas was the first time I used them since I moved here nearly five years ago, thanks to a newly acquired smaller artificial tree that fit perfectly into my living room. I thoroughly enjoyed seeing the ornaments again after such a long time. As I unwrapped each of them, I felt like I'd met an old friend I hadn't seen in a really long time. And the memories began to flow.

The small paper cup and the little wooden spool covered in foil, resembling bells; a paper swan from "The Twelve Days of Christmas" looked a bit arthritic but still recognizable; a cottonwood tree pod made to look like a mouse, and the fragile, 90-year-old ornaments of our childhood made my heart sing, as did the small old-fashioned Santa Claus ornament from Germany,

which had been my husband's. So many others, all with their own story. Remembering, touching the past, was an amazing feeling. A cup of strong eggnog couldn't have done a better job of pushing me high on the feel-good scale!

Research tells us indulging in nostalgia is a good thing, a healthy thing, it helps generate creativity, keeps us emotionally sound, gives life meaning, and is an overall good place to visit. But it's not good to stay there too long since the benefits are erased when we do that. We used to call it "strolling down Memory Lane," now "nostalgia" is the new buzz word. Whatever, it's good for us, it doesn't cost anything, doesn't have any bad side effects, and doesn't make us fat or retain fluid! I'm more than happy to dip into it every now and then and come out feeling content and happy.
