LHS: Leadership; Honor; Service

Congratulations Loyal High School senior! You have been nominated as a potential recipient for the LHS Award, sponsored by Dennis and Michele Gorke. This \$300 cash award will be earned by one Loyal High School senior who displays the LHS traits of **L**eadership, **H**onor, and **S**ervice.

**LEADERSHIP** includes traits such as the ability to delegate, to inspire, and to communicate effectively. Other important leadership traits that will be considered are a student's honesty, confidence, commitment, and creativity.

**HONOR** is a matter of carrying out, acting, and living the values of respect, duty, loyalty, selfless service, integrity, and personal courage. A commitment to an honorable life, then, is a commitment to doing what is right, and to admitting when you do not reach that high standard.

**SERVICE** is when you do something for someone else without the intention of getting a reward or money. This service should benefit someone other than yourself, and it should be done because you would like to help and not because you are required to help.

If you would like to become an applicant for the LHS Award, complete an essay wherein you reflect upon and acknowledge your LHS attributes, as well as how you foresee yourself carrying on with these attributes in your future.

Submit your essay (limited to one typed page) to Mr. Doug Dieckman, Loyal High School Principal, by the last day in February. All essays will be evaluated by a committee of LHS staff. The recipient of this award will be announced at the Senior Banquet in May.
