# An Overview of Auxiliary Services

#### **Before-Care**

Before-Care allows HMS families to drop off their child(ren) prior to the beginning of the child's regular school day. Before-Care runs from 7:15 - 8:15am daily, and we have rooms for our YCC community (YCC Room) and our Children's House and Above Levels (Activity Room). Families may register on a yearly, monthly, or daily basis. If looking to register for a yearly basis, contact Tim McQuait. To register as needed by month or day, please do so online by clicking here.

#### **After-Care**

After-Care allows HMS families to pick-up their child(ren) after the regular school day ends at 3:00pm. Pick-up can occur as late as 6:00pm each day. Like Before-Care, there are separate rooms for our YCC community (YCC Room) and Children's House and Above Levels (Activity Room). Families may register on a yearly, monthly, or daily basis. #### "School's Out"

On weekdays where we do not have school, we offer "School's Out." "School's Out." is an all-day program that allows students to be dropped off as early as 7:15am and picked up as late as 5:45pm for a flat fee. It is staffed by regular auxiliary staff and other HMS subsitutes, so your child will see many familiar faces. #### Clubs


