

#### Spring sports try-outs begin on January 30, 2023!

A recent physical exam (within one year of your last physical) is required for clearance to participate in try-outs. Also, if your prior physical exam will expire in the middle of the season (ex: February 30, 2023), you will be required to submit an updated physical exam at that time (or earlier) to continue to be eligible to participate.

Please note that many are experiencing delays when scheduling appointments with their doctor. Do NOT wait! Schedule an appointment NOW with your personal physician so there is no delay in being able to participate! If you find that you are unable to schedule a physical exam with your personal physician in time for try-outs, there are several Urgent Care Centers in the area that may be able to assist you (see attached list). A copy of the preferred physical exam form is also attached for your convenience.
