*Homework Help, a judgement free environment in which teens with autism can hang out, sing, dance, and play games. The program includes a variety of social activities including music, dancing, art, games, crafts, and more. The goal is to create a social environment, promoting social skills, listening, and communicating as well as building peer relationships and friendships.*

*The program will follow the Torrington School District calendar as well as school closings.*
