Berlin British School - Primary School Leave of Absence and Absenteeism

in accordance with the *AV Schulbesuchspflicht* valid as from 19 November 2014 in its version from 24.08.2022

Pupils' absence from school is considered <u>authorised</u> if the Head of School grants leave <u>or</u> if parents/ guardians excuse their children's absence due to illness or other unforeseen important reason(s) in retrospect.

1. Special Leave of Absence

Parents/ guardians, if requesting leave of absence for their child, must do so in writing at least 14 days in advance of their child's absence, stating reasons. Requests for leave of absence must be addressed to <u>both</u> the **Head of Primary** <u>and</u> the child's **class teacher**.

a. The Head of Primary **may** give permission of up to ten days of annual leave of absence, depending on the circumstance.

2. Reasons for Leave of Absence

Leave of absence will be granted on a case-by-case basis. Pupils can be granted leave of absence for the following:

- a. personal reasons; e.g. doctor's appointments
- b. family reasons; e.g. marriage, death of a close relative
- c. leave of absence before or after school holidays shall only be granted in exceptional cases.

3. Absences - Procedures

Absences owing to illness or other unforeseen important reasons:

- a. Parents/ guardians must complete the <u>online form</u> only to inform the school of their child's absence on the first day of absence before 8.30 am.
- b. The <u>online form</u> is available on the Primary School's website
- c. If the school is not informed of a child's absence, the school will make contact with the parents/ guardians on the first day of the pupil's absence.

4. Unauthorised Absences

Absences which are neither communicated within the aforementioned deadlines nor sufficiently explained in retrospect will be deemed <u>unauthorised</u>.

a. Unauthorised absences from school

- → the school will contact the absent pupil's parents/ guardians on the first day of their absence
- b. If a pupil has 5 days of unauthorised absence from school in one term:
 - → The school is obliged to inform the Berlin Senat (school authorities).
 - → After a further five days of unauthorised absence, the Senat will be notified again.
 - → The Senat then informs the Jugendamt (youth welfare office) and the educational psychology service about the absence.
 - → The school will invite the pupil's parents/ guardians to a meeting. The Senat will determine further procedures in accordance with the Berlin School Law (§ 126 SchulG).

5. Absences due to illness

If your child is absent due to illness, a doctor's note must be submitted to the class teacher after three days of absence i.e. your child must see a doctor on the third day of absence.

It is not necessary to submit a doctor's note if your child has been sick for only two days, but the <u>online form</u> must be completed on the first day of absence.
