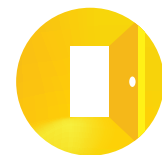

WE ARE THRILLED TO ANNOUNCE THE NEXT SEMESTER OF AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING (ASP)!

If you would like your child to participate in After School Programming (ASP), here are some things to know:

1. There is no additional cost to attend ASP
2. ASP is optional and is open to all students who are showing **safe and kind** behavior AND are able to **stay with the group without 1:1 support**.
 - Students who want to participate may attend Tuesdays and/or Thursdays
3. ASP will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school from 3:15 pm – 5 pm.
 - Each group will meet **1 day/week (Tuesdays or Thursdays)** for a semester
 - Each semester will have **10 sessions** (no ASP during Spring Break)
 - **Spring Tuesdays:** February 21, 28 / March 7, 14, 21, 28 / April 11, 18, 25 / May 2
 - **Spring Thursdays:** February 23 / March 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 / April 13, 20, 27 / May 4
4. Parents must provide transportation home at 5 pm
 - Rideshare will only be permitted for students ages 18+
 - Carpool or non-parent pick up will be allowed with signed consent.
5. ASP will be led by O-School staff members
6. ASP is not open to TLC (Transition Classroom) students, who have their own separate activities and programs.

ASP DAILY SCHEDULE:

- 3:15 pm - 3:30 pm - Transition/Snack (with ASP group)
- 3:30 pm - 4:45 pm – Programming!
- 4:45 pm - 5 pm - Dismissal
