SIC report from Anayansie Park

- Only item was moving advisory time.

Counselor report from Anena Gardner

- Still doing 8th grade CCR meetings. Not in February due to being busy with other events.
- Career week is coming up. Parents will be coming in on Friday of that week to talk about their careers.

Principal's report from Adrian Bancroft

- School fees
 - Question from Caroline about how many families struggle (need waiver) – not allowed to track that information. But families that apply to get it waived almost always got those waived. All fees on left side are all waivable. The optional fees are not waivable. Note – the required ones are for materials for the class, etc. To participate in the class, you need to pay the fee.
 - Question from Aimee Burrows. If you don't pay, do you get kicked out? A reasonable effort is made to collect, but that is between the financial secretary and the parents – it doesn't come up with the student.

- Bryan Jensen introduced himself as new board member. Question about whether we can get updates on the legislative session starts.
