Administrative Regulation: Foreign Exchange Students

I. Eligibility:

In order for a foreign exchange student to be eligible for enrollment in the Coventry Public Schools, the following criteria must be met:

- A. The student must be sufficiently fluent in English so that the student would not require any special services such as ESL.
- B. The student may not be a graduate of a secondary school system in another country or have received a diploma from a school in the United States.
- C. The application for admission must be reviewed by the appropriate school administrator of the school year for which the student wishes to enroll and receive approval from the Superintendent or designee.
- D. The school must have room for the student and be able to accommodate the student without incurring additional costs or burdens.
- E. The student may not be enrolled more than one year.
- F. Students entering the United States on F-I visas may attend schools in the district only upon full payment of tuition before entering the United States. This tuition fee may not be waived due to federal legislation.
- G. This program is designed for foreign students who enter the country on one-year J-I visas through established exchange programs such as Youth for Understanding, American Field Service and Rotary.
- H. All students shall meet state and District immunization requirements.

II. Participation Privileges:

- A. The student is not eligible to receive a diploma but can receive an honorary diploma.
- B. The student may be eligible to play sports if the student meets the CIAC criteria.

III. Conditions for Continued Enrollment:

If the student is not participating in and attending the school program or is disruptive to the smooth and efficient operation of the school, the student may be disenrolled.
