Purpose:

GOALS:

The primary goal of the PROGRESS program is to provide students with learning differences opportunities in the classroom as well as community based vocational activities that prepare the students for successful employment.

The long range goals of the program are to motivate students at SCHS and in the community, to increase the confidence and self-image of youth who strive to meet challenges, and to increase the cooperation between schools and businesses in preparing youth for productive employment.

JOB SHADOWING:

The purpose of job shadowing is to provide students with the opportunity to volunteer in a variety of Clark County businesses and settings. Through their own observation and the performance of job duties, students are able to explore career interest areas. Job shadowing is an opportunity for students to learn about a career, to understand employers expectations, to be able to practice appropriate social skills, and to begin defining their own vocational goals.
