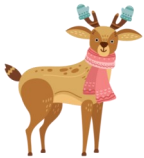


Longwood Public Library Presents

Calling all families in the Longwood District that are Yeti to Read! Join us this winter for a family reading club where children can earn virtual badges and prizes just for reading! This club is for all children up to 6th grade - including babies!



Signing up is easy! Just go to mylpl.beanstack.org (instructions on the back) and start logging your child’s reading! For every hour of reading they log, they will earn a virtual badge & a raffle ticket that can be used to enter into the raffle drawing of their choice...we have 7 great bundles! You can see all the choices under “Ticket Drawings”.



Everyone that reaches the 3 hour badge this winter will receive a “Midway Prize”... Children will get to select a prize from our overflowing treasure chest. If they complete the club and reach 7 hours of reading, they will receive a “Swag Bag” filled with a variety of fun prizes and a super soft, plush Yeti. Remember, the more they read or listen to books, the more raffle tickets they will earn!

Use your computer, smartphone or tablet to log the books you are reading (or listening to) and to participate in our 8 activity challenges.

Follow these simple steps to register individually or a family:

1. Go to mypl.beanstack.org
2. If you have already used Beanstack before, just login!
3. First time users, click on **Register an Individual or Family**
4. It will ask you if you want to register yourself or your child.
5. If registering as a family, the parent should begin by clicking **I am Registering Myself**. Once complete, follow the prompts to add another adult or child.
6. To view the challenge that each family member has enrolled in, simply click on the family member's name in the top right corner.
7. Once registered, access your account by logging into Beanstack using the username and password that you initially created.

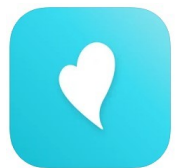

To log books or activities:

1. Sign into your Beanstack account. In the upper left corner click on **Log Reading and Activities**. From there, you will use the drop down menu to select the family member you are logging for.
2. For every hour of reading you log, you will earn a virtual badge & a ticket that you can use to enter into the raffle drawing of your choice. Click on **"Ticket Drawings"** to see our fabulous raffle bundles!
3. You will receive a **Signup Prize** when you register, a **Midway Prize** when you reach 3 hours and a **Swag Bag** filled with prizes when you reach 7 hours.
4. You can also earn badges & tickets by participating in our 8 **Activity Badges**. Check them out!

1. Touch **Find Your School or Library**
2. Type in "Longwood Public Library"
3. Touch **Sign Up!**
4. Enter your **library card barcode**
5. You can now create a username and password
6. Follow the prompts to complete the registration
7. Touch **Add a Reader** for additional family members
8. Scroll down and touch **See Available Challenges** and register for the **2023 WRC**
9. Touch the + at the bottom to log your reading!
