

Nutrition Service Account Protocol

(Updated August 2022)

Roseburg School District places a high level of importance in ensuring every child has access to a nutritious meal during the school day; and continues to serve all kids. Research has consistently found that kids do better in school when they eat regular, healthy meals. All students shall be given access to a meal. No student will be embarrassed in front of his/her peers by staff refusing to serve them or taking away food. To ensure our students are eating regular, healthy meals, we have established the following:

Roseburg School District is currently approved for CEP (Community Eligibility Provision) meaning that all students eat a breakfast and lunch for free.

- A. If a student has money in their account, they may purchase a second milk or meal. It is the parent's and/or guardian's responsibility to pay for all charges.
 - 1. Milk is included in the regular price of meals.
 - 2. Milk is also provided for free to students who bring their own lunch from home.

- B. The District cannot by law (HB 3454) refuse to serve a student that requests a meal, even if that student has brought a meal from home.

- C. If a balance is owed to a student when they leave the district, the parent/guardian has the following options available:
 - 1. Have the balance transferred to a sibling still in the district.
 - 2. Have a refund issued by contacting the Nutrition Services office at (541) 440-4023.

Adults

Parents and staff do not eat for free. Meal accounts will be set up as requested. Meals may not be charged. Payment must be made at time of service or pre-paid by putting funds into an account.
