C. Ice Cream Truck/Mobile Unit Vending

1) Definitions

“Frozen dessert/products” are any water/juice based product. For the purpose of food permitting at the Medford Board of Health, this is treated the same as “ice cream”.

“Ice Cream” is any frozen dairy or frozen water-based food product.

“Ice cream truck” any motor vehicle used for selling, displaying or offering to sell ice cream, or ice cream like products.

“Ice cream truck/mobile unit vending”, the selling or offering to sell ice cream, pizza, or any other prepared or pre-packaged food product from an ice cream truck/vehicle or mobile unit.

2) Permit Requirements

I. Mobile food permit - In addition to food permit requirements in 105 CMR 590.000 State Sanitary Code Chapter Minimum Standards for Food Establishments and M.G.L. 270, s 25., all operators (except ice cream vendors) must submit to:

- a) signed consent for a Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check and Sexual Offender Record Information (SORI) check
- b) photo identification
- c) current Massachusetts registration (the permit only applies to the specific registration of the vehicle registered) Other vehicles from the same company, but different registration will be considered un-permitted operation.

II. Ice cream mobile vendors - In addition to food permit requirements in 105 CMR 590.000 State Sanitary Code Chapter Minimum Standards for Food Establishments and M.G.L. 270, s 25., and 520 CMR 15.00 Permitting of Ice Cream Truck Vendors, all operators must submit to:

- a) No person shall engage in ice cream truck vending, as defined in 520 CMR 15.02 Definitions: Ice Cream Truck Vending or Medford Board of Health Regulation 1 unless the applicant has been issued a valid permit to do so by the Permitting Authority within the municipality where the permit applicant lives or intends to operate an ice cream truck. A permit must be issued for every person who intends to engage in ice cream truck vending.
- b) b) photo identification
- c) c) current Massachusetts registration (the permit only applies to the specific registration of the vehicle registered) Other vehicles from the same company, but different registration will be considered un-permitted operation.

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
