# A NOTE FROM OUR NURSE

#### A STRONG DEFENSE AGAINST FLU: GET VACCINATED!

Flu is a contagious respiratory disease that can lead to serious illness, hospitalization, or even death. CDC recommends everyone six months and older get an annual flu vaccine.

#### Is the flu vaccine safe?

• YES, Flu vaccines have a good safety record. Hundreds of millions of Americans have safely received flu vaccines over the past 50 years. #### What are the side effects of flu vaccines?

 Flu shots: Flu shots are made using killed flu viruses (for inactivated vaccines), or without flu virus at all (for the recombinant vaccine). So, you cannot get flu from a flu shot. Some minor side effects include soreness, redness and/or swelling where the shot was given, low grade fever, and aches.

#### When and Where to get vaccinated?


- You should get a flu vaccine during flu season. Flu cause the most illness during the colder months of the year. In the United States, flu season is from October to May
- As long as flu viruses are circulating, vaccination should continue throughout flu season.
- Flu vaccines are offered in many health care providers offices and clinics. Flu vaccine is available in many other locations, including health departments, Walgreens/CVS pharmacies, urgent care clinics, health centers, and travel clinics.





