



# Once committed to a college - Let's celebrate you!


- 1. Take a photo featuring your college/destination of choice

- Personal counselor transition





## Tips to Prepare for College Life

- 1. Reviewing emails sent to you from your college daily
  - a. READ the email THOROUGHLY
- 2. Missed mandatory deadlines can affect acceptance (CSU/UC)
- 3. Review awards make sure you are clear on cost before accepting award/choosing school
- 4. Create a schedule that works best for you
  - a. i.e. Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday
- 5. Start a checklist of things to prepare in summer
  - a. Supplies, books, schedule, parking permit, dorm rooms, roommates
- 6. If you are working, letting your employer know about your schedule
- 7. Let your parents know your plan for the semester/year consent for access
- 8. Get to know your professors
- 9. Make friends in class
  - a. Help build study groups, network with one another
- 10. Get involved in campus
  - a. Don't just go to school and go home
  - b. Get involved with campus organizations or clubs
