Principal Message

Parents and families:

We made it through the first semester of the year with FLYING COLORS! I am so proud of our kids and how much they have grown this past year. The previous two years were HARD for them, for families and for our staff. This required a LOT of re-teaching, reminders and some new learning for kids who had not been to middle school before. What successes have we had?

- 1. Our discipline data has shown decreases in suspensions and other major offenses.
- 2. Our attendance rates and tardy rates have decreased.
- 3. Our number of students passing most classes has increased.
- 4. Our focus on **Kindness**—1st quarter and **Bravery**-2nd quarter has shown positive results in students.
 - a.3rd quarter will focus on **Academics**—please talk to your students about their academic goals, check their Power School weekly with them and encourage them to do their best.
- 5. Instructional practices in the classrooms have re-immerged to engage students with their peers, respond to higher level questioning and take ownership in their learning. Ask your student what they are learning in their classes. They should be able to tell you!

We would love to have parents, families, grandparents and other positive adult role models involved at Highlands. We would love to have you hang out at lunch, be visible after school or volunteer in classrooms. Give us a call if you are interested. Our kids need you present.
