

Community Council Meeting Minutes

Meeting held in the LJH Media Center

1. Welcome – Stephanie Stapleton
 - a. Review of Minutes
2. Budget Review – TJ Strain
 - a. Encumbered funds yet to be spent by some departments.
 - b. Approximately \$18,000 will need to be reallocated in the March community council meeting.
 - i. Areas of need for these funds may include orchestra instruments, science lab equipment, and High-Reliability Schools Summit travel expenses.
 - c. The March 15th Community Council meeting will be held from 9:15 am to 1:15 pm. During this meeting, LAND Trust allocations will be made and approved by the community council.
3. TSSP Goals – Proposals and Timeline – TJ Strain
 - a. Review of the current year plan.
 - i. Goal 1 (97% of 9th-grade students leave LJH credit sufficient, and 94% of students will maintain course competency). Progress made toward this goal. Interventions such as Study Skills classes have been beneficial.
 - ii. Goal 2 (end-of-year assessment proficiency increase in core subject areas). Interventions in place include co-taught math and English classes and Math Gap classes in each grade level.
 - b. New Plan Ideas
 - i. Discussed the need for additional mental health support and suggested ideas to incorporate various strategies to aid students.
 - ii. Support expressed for writing academic goals similar to current academic goals.
