Phonics refers to the relationship between the letters of written language and the sounds of spoken language.

The following activities can build a child's ability to see the relationship between letters and sounds.

Using pictures in magazines/books and magnetic letters/letter cards:



1. Place the letter of the beginning (or ending) sound on the picture.

- 2. Play Swap One:
 - Create a CVC word cat
 - Swap one letter and read the word pat
 - Repeat pot
 - Read the word even if a make believe word is made poj
