

**Common Application for
Green High School PTSA Distinguished Student Scholarship and
Green Council of PTAs Outstanding Citizen Scholarship**

This scholarship application form is a common application for both the *Green High School PTSA Distinguished Student Scholarship* and the *Green Council of PTAs Outstanding Citizen Scholarship*. By completing this application, a student is eligible to be considered for both scholarships. However, any one student can only be awarded one scholarship. For the year 2023 there will be three \$500 Distinguished Student scholarships and two \$500 Outstanding Citizen scholarships, for a total of five scholarships.

The Green High School PTSA Distinguished Student Scholarship was established to recognize an outstanding graduating senior who has exhibited exemplary character, leadership, and involvement, as well as a commitment to his or her educational goals. This scholarship will be awarded based upon the evidence of character and leadership qualities, along with a student's academic record as certified by the Green High School Guidance Office and their extra-curricular activities.

The Green Council of PTAs Outstanding Citizen Scholarship was established to recognize a graduating senior who has exhibited exemplary service to his or her school, community, family, or place of employment. The scholarship will be awarded based upon the student's extra-curricular involvement and/or work history with an emphasis on their service to others.

To be eligible for either scholarship, the applicant must be:

1. Graduating from Green High School in May, 2023.
2. Have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
3. Be accepted at an accredited college, university or technical school.
4. You or an immediate family member must be a Green High School PTSA member.

Application Instructions:

1. Complete all four pages of this application form. Please type or print legibly. Use only the pages provided; however, pages 3 and 4 may be duplicated if additional space is needed. **Do not** attach a "resume" page of your activities, honors, etc. This application can also be found on the GHS website, either via the PTSA or Guidance Department pages, if you wish to download the document.
2. Attach an official school transcript.
3. All materials must be completed and returned to the GHS Guidance Office by 3 PM on **April 6, 2023**.
