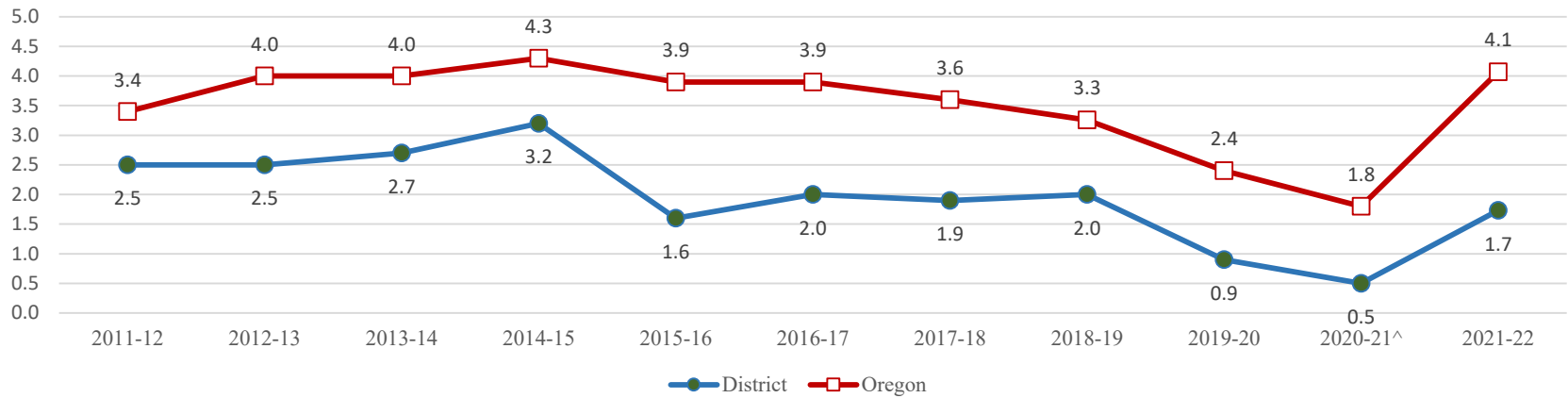

^ For the 2020-21 school year, the State Board of Education suspended the 10-day drop rule which requires districts to drop a student from enrollment if a student was absent beyond 10 days. In 2020-21, if a student stopped attending for 10 or more days, districts were required to continue trying to engage with the student and their families to encourage attendance or to receive confirmation that the student withdrew from school. If a student was absent beyond 10 days and met the criteria for continued enrollment due to the suspension of the 10-day drop rule, districts continued to count the student as enrolled.
