MEETING MINUTES

**Regular Meeting**

- A. **Called to order at 8:10 p.m. followed by the pledge of allegiance.**
- B. **ROLL CALL:** Mr. Robinson-Chair present, Mr. Brown Vice Chair came in late, Mr. Laverde present, Mrs. Bonnie Jones present.
- C. **CHANGES IN AGENDA:** No Changes to the agenda. Mrs. Jones moved to accept the agenda. Mr. Laverde 2<sup>nd</sup> Passed.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

The public is invited to attend Board meetings and will be given limited time during the open forum to voice opinions or concerns, except that all public or Board criticism of personnel of the district shall be heard only in executive session with the employee against whom the complaint is lodged present. (A written request to speak with the board in executive session must be received by the Superintendent five (5) business days prior to the Board meeting). No Board action may be taken under public comments.

**D. ACTION AGENDA ITEMS:**


- 1) **To Discuss Highway Closure and Reopening School:** Highway 2 will be open on Monday, Sept. 26, 2022. Open discussion on details of reopening.

Issues addressed related to reopening:

- a) **Students:** Be prepared for questions and anxiety with students. This is a traumatic experience and is an ongoing situation for students who live in the area or who have been evacuated to other areas. Some of the students are from out of the fire zone and this will be difficult for them as well.  
Need to address remote options for staff and students who have serious breathing issues (asthma, etc.), students who are still evacuated from area and students whose parents might request remote learning during active fire period.
- b) **Transportation:** reduced speed limit and varying pick-up times at bus stops, water, and non-perishable snacks on the bus in case of prolonged delays due to road work/fire work.
- c) **Communication:** A letter to parents with clear information outlining the schools plan for reopening and anything that might come up including students having to stay at the school overnight. Contact Stevens Pass to have another relocation/pick-up option for emergencies. Make sure school has good contact information for all students. Phone for Counselor to contact parents as needed. Students and staff to take laptops home daily in case of another closure so we can have classes remotely. Have parents send comfort kits (including a change of clothes) to school for their student(s) in case of delays in getting students home due to road closures.
- d) **School Building:** Run all air purifiers, keep doors and windows closed, N95 masks for students and staff to wear and indoor recess for students on smoky days, Re-stock emergency water, food and supplies as needed.
- e) **Food Service:** Make sure school has enough inventory to prepare breakfast and lunch on Tuesday.

Motion to reopen school. Mr. Brown moved to reopen school on Tuesday, September 27, 2022. Mrs. Jones 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed.

Adjournment: Mr. Laverde moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 p.m. Mrs. Jones 2<sup>nd</sup>.
