It is important to check with the schools of your choice regarding their Course Equivalency or Course Acceptance. **It is very important to have goals established for post high school before taking too many dual credit course hours.**

Core Complete (42 hours)	Associate Degree (61 hours)
Choosing Courses that transfer to your 4 year University	Specific Courses to complete a degree that may or may not transfer to your college of choice
Transfer of courses, but still allows for student to take courses at other higher institutions to transfer to their 4 year school	Completion of a degree, but max amount of credits that most Universities will take thus limiting or removing the ability for students to take other courses to transfer to their school of choice
Students that are Core Complete and go to a Texas State college will also be Core Complete for the University.
