A Parent Mentor is the parent of a child with a disability employed by local education agencies and Educational Services Centers to help families and school districts by providing support, information and training services.

All Parent Mentor services are free to parents .

A Parent Mentor guides families through the Special Education process by:

- Attending Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings and other meetings at the request of parents or staff.
- Helping families understand their rights and responsibilities
- Providing information and resources to families and schools.
- Listening to and supporting both family and educators on an individual basis.
- Engaging community service agencies and other resources to support families and schools.
- Hosting information sessions, support groups or workshops for families and professionals.
- Connecting families, schools and community to benefit students with special needs.
