5. Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship Follow Up- Brad Chapple
 - Brad passed out the school report on technology. Uploaded on Teams. Made corrections to #9.
 - Brad addressed how the school’s technology filters items with White Supremacy. It depends on the content. Anything with violence will be blocked and terrorism and radicalization.

6. Data Presentation – Brad Chapple
 - Look at data each January for the school improvement plan
 - Focusing on academics, mental health, behavioral and attendance
 - Aspire data (pre-ACT) for 9th graders
 - MJH’s 9th mean score is 200. The range is 184 – 210. We are #8 in the district of 19 junior high schools.
 - MJH’s 9th mean score is 198. The range is 143 – 211. We are #9 of the district of 19 junior high schools.
 - MJH’s 9th reading score is 202. The range is 186-211. We are #5
 - MJH’s 9th science score is 215. The range is 182-215. We are #1.
 - Aspire scores presented in a chart.

- 7th and 8th grade Language Art score is 8 points above average.
- 7th and 8th grade Math score is 42 at average
- 7th and 8th grade Science at 51 - 7 points above average.
- Looked at the breakdown of score specifics. All slides uploaded in Teams.
- Data shows we are positively progressing according to the state data gateway in language arts, math and science.
- Our school goal is to improve 4 points.
- Went over SHARP Survey on mental health.
