Turner Community Connection Inc. Scholarship

1. The applicant must be a current senior/early graduate of Turner High School
2. Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Attend a 2 or 4 year college or an accredited technical school taking no less than 12 hours per semester.
 - b. ACT score or 22 or higher
 - c. GPA of 2.5 in core classes
 - d. Has worked or volunteered outside of the school day.
3. To be considered please submit the following to Mrs. Yao in the counseling office.
 - a. Completed application (**must be typed**)
 - b. Obtain a copy of his/her current transcript from the counseling office and attach it to the application.
 - c. Short Answers
 - d. Two letters of recommendation. One from teacher and one from an employer or community service organization sponsor.
4. Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis and are renewable if the following guidelines are met. Award is \$500.00.
 - a. Maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA in college/technical school
 - b. Full time student with 12 credit hours per semester

Application Deadline is Tuesday, March 21st 2023.

Miller Family Scholarship in honor of Mary Louise Butler

1. Attended THS for the last two years of high school.
2. 3 years of math.
3. 3 years of science.
4. ACT score of 23 or higher.
5. GPA of 3.00 or higher.
6. Attending a 2 year or 4-year college taking no less than 12 hours per semester.
7. Has worked or volunteered outside of the school day.

Scholarships are awarded on a per semester basis and will be renewable for up to 5 years from high school graduation. Award is \$500 per semester with a maximum of \$1,000 per school year. This scholarship may not be used for summer school. This scholarship may be used for graduate school if it falls within the 5 years after high school graduation. **Application deadline is Friday, March 31st 2023.**

Rachel Elizabeth Telgemeier Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded on a **semester** basis and is renewable for up to 4 years from high school graduation. Award is \$1,000 per semester with a maximum of \$2,000 per school year. This scholarship may not be used for summer school.

Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Attended THS for the last two years for high school.
2. GPA of 2.50 or higher.
3. ACT score of 21 or higher.
4. Participated in a school-sponsored activity (such as band, sports, choir, student council, etc.)
5. Participated in a school-sponsored activity (such as band, sports, choir, student council, etc.).
6. Has worked or volunteered outside of the school day.

Guideline for re-application:

1. Scholarship is renewable. However, a semester review of all recipients and their progress is required for renewal.
2. Maintain a cumulative 2.50 GPA in college.
3. Full time student with at least 12 credit hours per semester

Application deadline is Friday, March 24th 2023.

Turner Foundation Scholarship

1. The applicant must be a current senior/early graduate of Turner High School
2. Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Parent or guardian is a Turner Foundation Pass Card Patron
 - b. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above **OR** ACT score of 21 or higher **OR** student is in the top 1/3 of his/her class
 - c. Plans to attend an area vocational/technical school, two year, or four-year university/college.
 - d. Participated in athletic, non-athletic, or community extracurricular activities (such as, but not limited to: KSHSAA sponsored activities, KAYS, NHS, scholars bowl, student council, community service, employment.)
 - e. Obtain and attach two letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and the other from a coach/sponsor/manager of choice. (such as, but not limited to: PTA officer, employment supervisor, clergy, community service supervisor).
 - f. Obtain a copy of his/her current transcript from the counseling office and attach it to the application.
3. Up to a total of \$5,000 in scholarship funds will be awarded to selected applicant(s).

Application Deadline is Friday, April 7th 2023.

Turner PTA/PTSA Scholarship

1. The applicant must be a current senior/early graduate of Turner High School
2. Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Student must be a current PTA or PTSA member within the Turner School District (any school)
 - b. Student must have completed a minimum of 8 hours of community service with the last calendar year for Turner PTA (any unit)
 - c. Complete the Record of Community Service that is part of the application process.
 - d. All applications must be accompanied by a self-written bio.
 - e. Check the application to see options to whom to send the application.

Application Deadline is Saturday, April 1st 2023.

Renee Michele Pretz Pernice Memorial Scholarship

1. This scholarship was created to honor the memory of Renee Michele Pretz Pernice, who was Valedictorian of the THS Class of 1991. Renee went on to obtain Bachelor and Master's degrees in Nursing and has distinguished careers as a Nurse and as an Instructor at St. Luke's College of Health Sciences.
2. The purpose of this scholarship is to help fund the education of a motivated, goal oriented Turner High School graduate planning to pursue a field of study to prepare for a career in Nursing.
3. Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Attended Turner High School for the last two years of high school
 - b. Grade point average of 3.0 or above
 - c. ACT score of 21 or higher
 - d. Plan to attend an accredited university/college with a subsequent plan to attend an accredited Nursing Program.
 - e. Participated in a school-sponsored activity (such as band, sports, drama, student council, etc.)
 - f. Worked or volunteered outside of the school day.
4. One scholarship worth \$1,000 will be awarded per school year.
5. To be considered please submit the following to Mr. Yao in the counseling office.
 - a. Completed Application (**must be typed**)
 - b. Obtain a copy of his/her current transcript from the counseling office and attach it to the application.
 - c. Short Answers (see Student Application Form)
6. Essay – Topic: How a career in Nursing would be meaningful and fulfilling to you.
7. Two Letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and one from an employer or community service organization supervisor.
8. **Application deadline is Friday, April 7th 2023.**

Jerry and Bernita Jones Scholarship

1. The applicant must be a current senior/early graduate of Turner High School
2. Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Attended Turner High School for the last two years of high School
 - b. 3 years of math reaching the level of Pre-calculus or above
 - c. 3 years of science in the following courses: Biology, Physical Science Chemistry, Physics, or Anatomy/Physiology
 - d. 2 years of the same foreign language
 - e. ACT score of 23 or higher
 - f. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 in core classes
 - g. Attending a 2 year or 4 year college and taking no less than 15 hours per semester.
 - h. Has worked or volunteered outside of the school day
3. This scholarship is awarded on a **semester** basis and will be renewable for up to 5 years from high school graduation. The scholarship money cannot be used toward summer school. Award is \$1,000 per semester with a maximum of \$2,000 per school year. The scholarship may be used for undergraduate or graduate studies.
4. Guidelines for re-application:
 - a. Scholarship is renewable. However, a semester review of all recipients and their progress is required for renewal.
 - b. Maintain a cumulative 2.75 GPA in college
 - c. Full time student with 15 credit hours
 - d. Student must major in a field related to math, science, computer technology, business, accounting, medicine or education.
 - e. This scholarship cannot be used for summer school.
 - f. Renewable up to 5 years from high school graduation, a maximum of \$2,000 per year.
5. To be considered please submit the following to Mrs. Yao in the counseling office.
 - a. Completed Application (**must be typed**)
 - b. Obtain a copy of his/her current transcript from the counseling office and attach it to the application.
 - c. Short Answers (see Student Application Form)
 - d. Two Letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and one from an employer or community service organization supervisor.

Application Deadline is Friday, March 24th 2023.

TURNER RECREATION COMMISSION

The Arthur C. Waugh scholarship program was established in 2003 by the Turner Recreation Commission Board. The program is dedicated to Mr. Arthur C. Waugh in recognition of his dedication and direction he provided the Turner Recreation Commission as a volunteer board member. Arthur, known by many as “Art”, was a true Turner community-minded individual. Art was revered by many of his fellow business associates and friends as a person that performed the “behind the scenes” work, whether it was providing financial support or volunteer time, Art was always willing to support the Turner youth in their endeavors. Turner Recreation Commission adopted a resolution on April 16, 2003 to name the community center building located at 831 South 55th street the Turner Recreation Commission Arthur C. Waugh Community Center.

REQUIREMENTS:

A. Applicant must be a Turner High School Senior who completed the last (4) years in the Turner Unified School District.

B. Applicant must have a current GPA of 2.70 (B- average).

B. Applicant must have a current or past affiliation with the Turner Recreation Commission including participation in TRC programs.

C. Applicants must return this application and a copy of their transcript to the Turner High School counseling office by Wednesday, April 12 2023.

D. Applicants must have performed both of the following services during their Turner High School years of attendance for the Turner Recreation Commission:

1. Served as an employee for the TRC in any capacity. (field maintenance, sports official, lifeguard, camp counselor, etc.)
2. Volunteered a minimum of 20 hours for TRC.

All applications are forwarded to the Turner Recreation Commission office for selection at the Turner Recreation Commission May board meeting. The Turner Recreation Commission Board will notify the Turner High School guidance office of the scholarship recipient(s). Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Turner High School Awards Ceremony. Turner Recreation Commission has up to five individual scholarships of up to \$500.00 that will be awarded to the top five qualifying applicants that apply.

Scholarship recipients will receive a letter of congratulations from the Turner Recreation Commission containing instructions on how the recipients can obtain their scholarship. The scholarship funds will be submitted directly to the recipient’s future attending college/continuing education institute. Recipients also receive an official scholarship certificate from the Turner Recreation Commission.
