

# Jerry and Bernita Jones Scholarship

## Criteria

**Purpose:** The purpose of this scholarship shall be to help fund the education of a motivated, goal oriented Turner High School graduate in a field of study related to math, science, computer science, education, medical, accounting or business.

**Criteria:** Students eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Attended THS for the last two years of high school.
2. 3 years of math reaching the level of Pre-calculus or above.
3. 3 years of science in the following courses: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy and Physiology.
4. 2 years of the same foreign language.
5. ACT score of 23 or higher.
6. GPA of 3.0 in core classes.
7. Attending a 2 year or 4 year college taking no less than 15 hours per semester.
8. Has worked or volunteered outside of the school day.

**Guidelines:** Scholarships are awarded on a per semester basis and will be renewable for up to 5 years from high school graduation. Award is \$1,000 per semester with a maximum of \$2,000 per school year. This scholarship may not be used for summer school. This scholarship may be used for graduate school if it falls within the 5 years after high school graduation.

**Guidelines for re-application:**

1. Scholarship is renewable. However, a semester review of all recipients and their progress is required for renewal.
2. Maintain a cumulative 2.75 GPA in college.
3. Full time student with 15 credit hours.
4. Major in a field related to math, science, computer technology, business, accounting, medicine or education.

**Amount:** Renewable up to 5 years from high school graduation, a maximum of \$2,000 per year.

**Deadline:** Application deadline is Friday, March 24, 2023. This application must be typed.
