


What is Agriculture Education?

Agriculture Education is a hands on learning approach within Career Technical Education (CTE) elective credit-bearing courses. Students must be enrolled in an agricultural education course to be enrolled in the National FFA Organization. ALL COURSES are A-G approved for graduation and college credit!

Agriculture Education courses consist of three segments depicted in the 3-Ring Model

- Classroom Instruction
- Supervised Agriculture Experience (SAE)
- National FFA Organization
