While reading for enjoyment is aligned to SC State Standards (e.g. Reading and Complexity), a reasonable person would not be able to equate reading of this text to improved academic achievement.

pervasive vulgarity

Throughout the text, there are at a minimum, 27 obscene/graphic/suggestive descriptions, and depictions of sexual conduct. Some of the content is in relationship to rape and violations of the female body while other content pertains to what would otherwise be described as a mutual physical relationship. What the author calls love, however, is not true love in the sense that people who have been married for a long time understand love, rather the author's depiction is more akin to worldly lust, a concept often misconstrued for love. Illustrations on pages 13, 55, 101, 105, 113, 128, and 177 are unnecessary and would circumstantially be violations of the Progressive Discipline Plan and SC State Law.

Evidence from the text relating to APPROPRIATENESS:

suitable material for minors (appropriateness) The intended audience for the text is 14+. Prevailing community standards would not allow for the obscene/graphic/suggestive depictions of sexual conduct in this book to be considered suitable material for minors. SC State Law Section 16-15-305 (Disseminating, procuring or promoting obscenity unlawful) states that it is a violation of state law for [paraphrased] a person to knowingly provide or offer any obscene writing, picture or other representation or description of the obscene. The law goes on to define obscene, and sexual conduct in ways that are aligned to IS – 38, appealing the average person and community standard.
