

## BUSINESS AND NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

### Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

The School Board, in cooperation with the Superintendent, shall draft a Capital Improvements program (CIP) which will project School Division needs for a six-year period. Individual capital projects shall be assigned priorities. The program shall be reviewed and updated annually. Copies shall be submitted to the School Board governing body for review and consideration.

*The Long-Range School Facility Master Plan serves as an ongoing resource for the School Division's anticipated capital improvement needs.*
