





FACILITY WALKTHROUGHS - Consistent Themes Throughout







- Heating, cooling & ventilation needs
- Windows are single pane, not properly insulated, needed for ventilation, difficult to open



- No/not enough dedicated rooms
- In former closets (no daylight) or hallways
- Location not always ideal far away, not well distributed
- Lack of privacy




- No individual and/or accessible student toilets
- Access issues at main entries, specials, door clearances
- Not enough accessible playground elements



- Grade levels not always co-located "bubble year" means classes are not together
- Lack of flexible space and furniture, 21st Century spaces
- Lack of storage space for teachers, students (narrow lockers), and overall building storage
- Rooms used by specials are converted into classrooms making scheduling difficult



- Lack of parking at most sites
- Many CIPs funded by PTA or Fathers' Club
- Poor WIFI and cellular service
- No/not enough faculty spaces, co-mingled work and break rooms
