Box 998 Richmond, KY 40476, or in person, to Farm Bureau offices in Richmond or Berea by April 17, 2023. Student must be a child of Farm Bureau member in good standing. ## **MADISON COUNTY FARM BUREAU FEDERATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

### **Eligibility**

**The Madison County Farm Bureau Scholarship fund will award 2 regular membership scholarships, 1 Associate member scholarship and 1 Agriculture Scholarship to high school seniors for the current school year. Scholarships may be applied to housing, tuition, and other educational expenses. Payments will be made Directly to the student, when proof of admission is submitted to the Treasurer of Madison County Farm Bureau Federation.**

**To be eligible, applicant must:**

- Have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA (on 4.0 scale)**
- Be the child of a Madison County Farm Bureau member (past 2 years). And remain such while the scholarship is in force.**
- Finish high school within the year they apply for the scholarship.**

### **Rules**

**Recipient may enter any accredited college or trade school; but must pursue a 2-4-year course of study.**

**Recipient must enter college as a beginning freshman no later than the fall semester following high school graduation, unless a circumstance beyond the student's control, such as serious illness or injury, prevents enrollment at that time. In such a case, recipient must enter college by the spring semester of the following year of the scholarship.**

**Dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, shall cause the recipient to lose the scholarship.**

**Winner must be a full-time student each semester unless exception is requested and approve.**

**Winner is required to submit a school schedule of registration each semester unless an exception is requested and approved.**

**All application materials must be postmarked by April 17, 2023, or hand delivered by that date. Mail to Madison County Farm Bureau P.O. Box 998, Richmond, KY 40476 or in person to any Madison County Farm Bureau office.**

**The scholarship committee along with the board of directors will make the final determination on all cases concerning the interpretation of these rules. All applications become the property of the Madison County Farm Bureau Federation**

and will not be returned.

**MADISON COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP**

The Madison County Farm Bureau Federation sponsors four (4) \$2000.00 scholarships to graduating seniors each year. Students eligible must have a 2.0 standing or higher, plan to attend college or vocational trade school this fall, and your parents/guardian must be a member of the Madison County Farm Bureau Federation for past 2 consecutive years.
