Wendy talked briefly about the findings and encouraged the group to read through it at their convenience.

Wendy will be retiring and Val Sullivan will be our new Curriculum Director starting January 15<sup>th</sup>. The team moving forward is led by Val, Ashley Creighton, and Robin Genetti. The three ladies talked a little about their roles.

Robin is the After School and Summer Program Coordinator. The focus is on social-emotional learning. There are lots of opportunities for learning while still making it fun and engaging for students. Hopefully ESSER funds will be available to amp up the summer program.

Ashley is working on identifying school differences to make sure there is equity across the district. She is in collaboration with math and literacy interventionists as well as looking at behavioral needs to ensure students stay in class. She is also working on making report cards more family friendly.

Val is working on Curriculum Alignment to make sure our schools are on the same page. She is working with teachers to become familiar with their current practices and to help ensure fluidity throughout the district.

DReilly commended the team for being hands on with teachers, coordinators, interventionists, and principals. Wendy is very happy with the team and said we're headed in the right direction.
