

FAQ about Burr Oak Registration

How do I register?

All registrations will be done online using the link below and will open at 10a on Jan. 30th.

When will I know if my child has been enrolled?

All registration is done through our organization partner CampBrain. Once live, the link will take you to their registration site and ask you to create a family account. This is a one time requirement that will automatically update your information each year.

Once you have entered the names, birthdays, and the current grades of your children you will be able to select any of the session offerings available to them. As soon as you have made your selections your spot will remain secure for 1 hour giving you time to complete the registration and payment process.

Do I have to pay for all of my selections at once?

No, CampBrain gives you the option of paying for your choices in structured installments.

What happens if I am placed on the waiting list?

CampBrain records all registrations in the order that they come in. Once each section fills all subsequent registrations are automatically placed onto a waitlist in the same manner.

You will be notified that all sessions /sections are full on the selections page. You will have the choice to place your name on the wait list; no payment will be required at that time.

CampBrain will notify you if a spot becomes available for your child.

What if I register and ultimately cannot attend Burr Oak?

A \$50 service fee is applied to all refunds through May 31st.

No refunds will be issued on/after June 1st.

Can my child be placed with their friends?

Although we will try to accommodate requests we cannot guarantee that campers will be placed accordingly.



FAQ about the Burr Oak Experience

Is there an age/grade minimum/maximum for enrollment?

We enroll pre-k children as young as 4 years old through current 6th grade students.

How are campers grouped together?

Each of our individual age/gender groupings are limited to 15 campers. While we offer multiple groupings at each age/gender level we keep the individual numbers small in order to maximize the engagement and interaction that makes Burr Oak so special.

Do you offer prorated session rates for partial attendance?

Due to the incredibly high demand for enrollment we do not offer these options.

Will my child learn how to swim at Burr Oak?

We have an incredible aquatics program that is led by an expert instructor. Every day our pre-k through 2nd grade campers will spend 50 minutes in the pool receiving lessons that are appropriate for their ability level. Our 3rd grade campers will each spend 5 of the 10 days in the pool, while our 4th-6th grade campers will take part in activities that do not include swimming.

What activities are offered at Burr Oak?

We are always evolving and advancing our offerings at Burr Oak. These offerings will change from session to session, but may also change week to week. Our goal is to provide our campers with a valuable experience that not only highlights social interaction, but places an emphasis on physical activity, problem solving, and creative engagement.

Some of our offerings include outdoor education, cycling, golf and putt-putt, coding, art, and reading.

Is lunch offered to campers?

A family style lunch is provided each day as part of the cost of camp. Snacks will also be provided throughout the day.
