Learn the language of doctors, nurses, and health-care professionals in a state-of-the-art facility. With an emphasis on Medical Assisting, students practice skills in pediatric ambulatory care, surgical instrument prep, vital signs, treatment room procedures, CPR/First Aid, law and ethics, medical terminology, infection control, patient positioning, and office practices including patient records. Program includes field trips, guest speakers, team building, and leadership activities and prepares students for further education or an exciting career. Successful completion of Biology strongly recommended prior to enrolling. Students read college level textbooks and practice technical writing skills.

Following the WANIC Medical Careers program students may choose to pursue the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) credential. Graduates who obtain a CMA credential from the American Association of Medical Assisting will receive the Medical Assistant Certified endorsement by the state of Washington.

Students who successfully complete the WANIC Medical Careers program have the opportunity to pursue a career as a Certified Medical Assistant. Students may choose to further their education toward qualifying as a Nurse, Medical Office Manager, Phlebotomist, Dialysis Technician, Emergency Room Technician, Physician Assistant, or Medical Doctor.
