This is a full year 3-period Skill Center class (3 high school credits). This exciting STEM enriched course prepares individuals to engage in the specialized servicing and maintenance of all types of automobiles. Students learn in National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) accredited training facilities. Students are well prepared to further their automotive education at post-secondary institutions, enroll in college engineering programs, or pursue a career in the automotive industry.

Topics revolve around the eight nationally recognized Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) areas. Leadership, Interpersonal, ASE supplemental tasks, and 21st Century Skills are embedded throughout this course along with a heavy correlation to science, physics, and chemistry and cross-referenced to the Next Generation Science Standards. Students read college level textbooks and practice technical writing skills.
