Parents will enter the north entrance and be met

		<p>by attendants who will direct you and form a line for distribution.</p> <p><b><u>Parents will not leave their vehicle.</u></b></p> <p>Distribution will begin precisely at 4:00pm.</p> <p>Distribution will end precisely at 6:00pm and will serve to the last vehicle that is within the confines of the parking lot. This is per USDA regulations that are strictly enforced.</p> <p>There will be a distribution point in the parking lot where an attendant will require the names and ages of the children to be served.</p> <p>Attendants will then place the appropriate sacks of pre-packaged food and a gallon of milk within the vehicle as per instructions by the driver. You will then be directed to the south exit.</p> <p>Take care as you re-enter 36th Street traffic:)</p>
